"Insurance And You In A Wildfire Prone Area" with Susan Fereday and Brock Harl

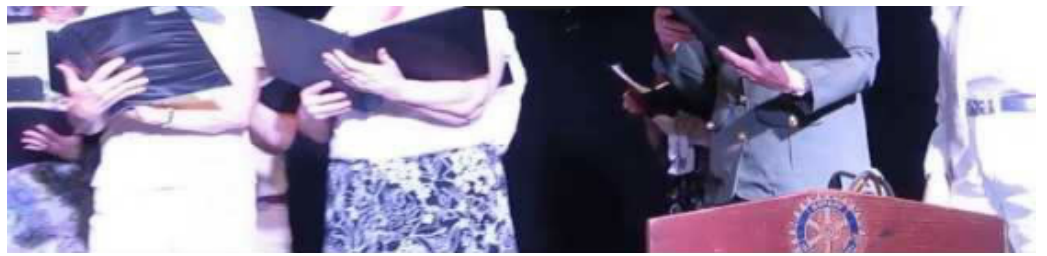

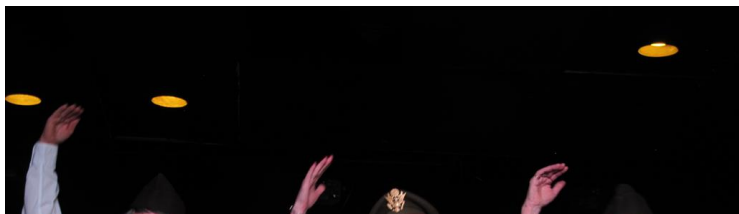
