

## Bill Solms, Doug Mann and Anne Slack presented scholarships to 11

students at the annual awards assembly at Estes Park High School last week. In all, 24 seniors received over \$115,000 in 74 scholarships that evening from generous funding organizations. The Rotary Club of Estes Park, as always, led the pack with a total of \$42,500 in awards, which was 37 percent of the total given to the students.




