# **Shred-a-thon date, request for sponsors**

Club members have the opportunity to sponsor the October 13 Shred-a-thon, with their donations benefitting the scholarship fund.

"Please consider being a sponsor and help us to continue providing this service to our community and scholarships for our students," Tara Moenning asks.

The Oct. 13 Shred-a-thon will have some new features. Tara outlines them as follows:

- 1. We will be using a new vendor and will have two 6,000 lb. capacity trucks to increase our total available capacity by 20 percent.
- 2. We will be offering a new service to businesses/individuals that have 10+ boxes. For these businesses or individuals, who wish to be a sponsor for the trucks, we will be offering a <u>scheduled appointment time</u> and we will be expediting their loads. With sponsors for the trucks, we will be able to continue to make all donations available for scholarships.
- 3. There will be a <u>minimum</u> donation of \$10 per box or bag. Remember, all donations go to our Rotary Scholarship Fund.
