3. Improve access to mental health services”

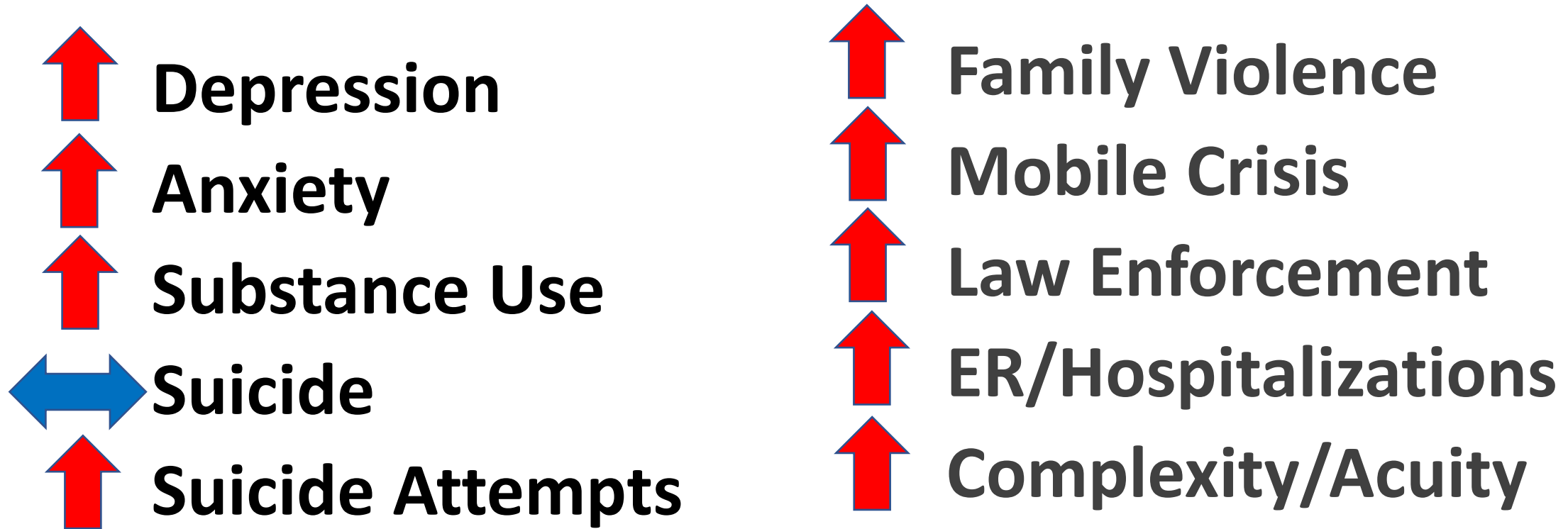

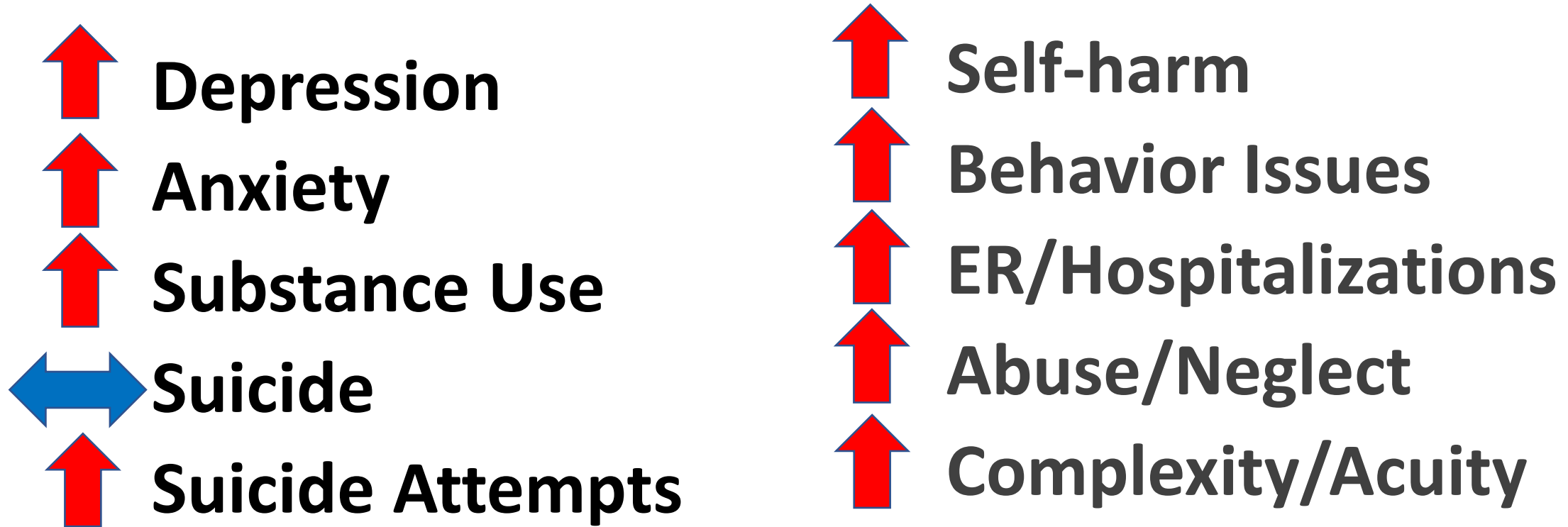

- Residential Care – Garcia House
 - Referrals from across the state
 - Co-occurring diagnoses (SUD, MH), often with criminal legal involvement
 - 16 beds
 - Medicaid coverage
 - Intensive residential care, medically monitored
 - Includes withdrawal management

About BHS



2018: Larimer County voters passed a **20-year ballot initiative** that dedicates a 0.25% sales-and-use tax (\$.25 on \$100) for behavioral health purposes.

BHS utilizes three funding pathways to invest back into the community.

- 1 Behavioral Health Services at Longview Campus**
- 2 Impact Fund Grant Program**
- 3 Bridge Fund (Future Initiative)**

Longview Campus



- 40-acre county-owned, behavioral health campus
- Northwest corner of Taft Hill and W. Trilby Roads
- **Acute Care** - The first building, will address a critical gap in crisis services including withdrawal management and crisis stabilization.
- **Adolescent Care** - The next building planned
