Jerry Westbrook (*Four Way Test*): Jerry shared comments from 8th graders who participated in Four Way Test sessions at Turner Middle School. Here are some highlights:

"I liked the way everyone was working together and there were no arguments... how it shows kids how to be responsible and to do the right thing, so they don't get into trouble!"

"I learned a new way of thinking and how other students talked about things like bullying and drug abuse."

"Discussing these things in front of the group was kind of hard to do."

Dave Mills (*Literacy*): Dave first explained the great benefits of getting TSD teachers trained in Dyslexia screening and teaching. He asked for donations needed for training 10 teachers this next year. Next, Dave presented \$9,300 (both a LRC Foundation grant and a donation from an anonymous Rotarian) to Ellie Benjamin of *United Way of Larimer County* for our local Dolly Parton Imagination Library program!

James Clegern (*New Mbr Thumbnail*): James treated us to his extremely brief life story, which included these highlights:

- James was an Air Force *military brat* that traveled all over Europe.
- He's always loved community outreach work, ever since he was a boy scout (became an Eagle Scout).
- After getting a degree in aerospace engineering, he did engineering work in the Air Force - e.g., building, testing, developing, deploying, and... blowing things up!
