Glenda's organization provides affordable wellness and health care for horses, cattle, sheep, goats and household pets throughout the 27,000 square mile Navajo Nation. Access to affordable healthcare for animals is limited and the Animal Rez-Q strives to fill this gap.

Animal Rex-Q also provides stipends to Navajo youth to encourage them to learn and be the next generation to care for animals on the reservation.
