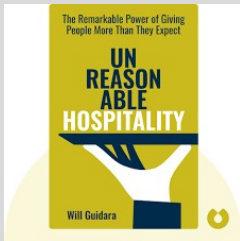

Legacy Giving

Chris White kicked off the program by relating the 4-Way Test to the many ways that Rotary provides generosity and introduced the concept of legacy giving is **When Planning Meets Purpose**.

Charlie Bouchard provided information on the simple steps to leaving a legacy - Think, Plan and Communicate. Charlie went on to explain more about the documents needed to make your plans known when you can no longer speak for yourself. He recommended the guide, **“I’m Dead, Now What?”**.

Laura Armstrong continued the program with information of how to give to the **Loveland Rotary Foundation** as well as examples of what the funds contributed go towards. The Foundation will provide as much as \$200,000 in scholarships in 2026. One example is the fund **Antoinette Lorenz** established in her estate to assist students seeking construction trade education.

John Kindschy completed the program with information related to **The Rotary Fund** and an example of what these international funds support including the Dignity Liberia program which provides maternal, pre-natal healthcare in Liberia.
