NoCO Humane became a reality when the Larimer and Weld county shelters merged in late 2023. NoCO

Humane is an independent 501(c)3, non-profit agency, not attached to any government organization. The

agency has a little more than 100 employees and over 500 volunteers. In the most recent year, NoCO Hu-

mane provided care for more than 10,000 animals and that is projected to grow to over 12,000 this year.

NoCO Humane provides services from adoptions and animal protection to education and foster care. With an

annual budget over \$9 million, the group will open a new campus in Weld County later this year. More
