### LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

**Moofie Miller** introduced the program - *Paramedics and Ambulance Services: What Happens When You Call 911*.

**Robert Carmosino**, a Battalion Chief with LFRA, started the program by sharing information and instructions on what Club members need to know when performing CPR.

Robert also provided instructions on the use of AEDs which are available in most public buildings.

**Michelle**, a 911 Operator, continued the program with information about how 911

operates and what to expect if/when you call 911. The Loveland 911 service is staffed by four people each day who receive an average of 357 calls per day. The operators are not medical providers and are trained to ask questions designed by physicians to help determine what is needed in each situation. Texting 911 is also available in most areas of Colorado but makes things much slower.

The program closed with information from **Matt**, a Battalion Chief with Thompson Valley EMS. Matt shared his appreciation for the community support his organization receives. He also promoted the use of the File for Life to help EMS responders.
