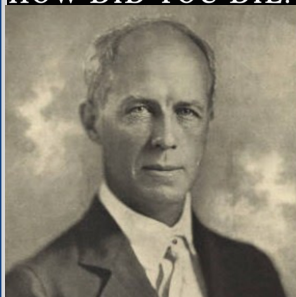

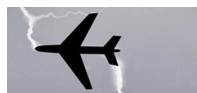

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Mark Anderson delighted us with a recap of important ripple effects from this spring's Navajo

Nation Horse Medicine Service Trip. Highlights:

RIPPLE 1 - The Horses: Mark and the team involved in these vet medicine trips help horses that would otherwise never get the basic care they desperately need.

RIPPLE 2 - The Teams: Soon-to-graduate vet students rotate among teams of horse farriers, dentists, surgeons, and anesthesiologists to get well-rounded.

RIPPLE 3 - Student Education: These mission trips provide hands-on horse care training to these vet students - something they have never yet been exposed to.

RIPPLE 4 - The Community: The mission protects these Native American people from horse-carrying disease (rabies) and some of the students return to their tribal communities to continue treating horses.
