### Memorial Day Program

**Steve Foster** introduced **Chief Warrant Officer 4 - Darren E. Freyer** (U.S. Army) to present the special Memorial Day program.

Born at Poudre Valley Hospital CWO Freyer has a 27-year career in the service and is now a member of the Colorado Army National Guard. Most of his time in the military has been spent as a Medivac pilot in helicopters. CWO Freyer shared stories of young men who sacrificed their lives in the service and asked the Club to remember those who were never able to fully live their lives. On Memorial Day this serves as a reminder of the cost of the freedom we all enjoy.
