(Blasts from the Past) What a difference 100 years can make! Here are some (selected) statistics (1922):

- The average life expectancy for men was 47 years.
- Only 14% of homes had a bathtub, and only 8% of homes had a telephone.
- The avg wage was 22 cents per hour, and the avg worker made between \$200 to \$400 per year.
- Most women only washed their hair once a month, usually using shampoo containing Borax or egg yolks.
- Two out of every 10 adults could read and write, and only 6% of all Americans had graduated from high school.
- There were only 230 murders (total) reported in the U.S.
