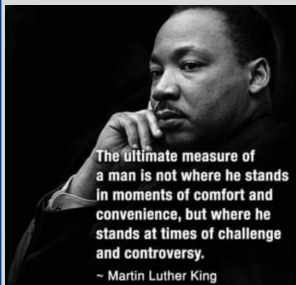

- During COVID, we heard from > 600 parents that if BGCLC had not been there for them, they would have been unable to keep working (it costs avg \$188 per week per child for childcare!).
- Dynamic, state-of-the-art youth programming has been essential to our success.

- We exist to serve kids no matter what is happening, and we are steadfast in that mission!
