audio clips of the era. The journey included Pearl Harbor attack; sale of U.S. savings bonds and stamps; sugar, gasoline, and shoe rationing; wartime songs, films, and radio programs; invention of zip codes; national "dimout" of electric lighting; invention of Spam; and the atomic bomb ending the war. Concluding, he returned to today's situation: "Hopefully we'll get through this global war just as we got through WW II... it's time for us to come together and fight the pandemic."
