PROGRAM

Jim Willard, *Loveland Reporter-Herald's* writer of 2,300 "Trivially Speaking" columns, transported us through World War II events (1941-1945), using memorable audio clips of the era. The journey included Pearl Harbor attack; sale of U.S. savings bonds and stamps; sugar, gasoline, and shoe rationing; wartime songs, films, and radio programs; invention of zip codes; national "dim-out" of electric lighting; invention of *Spam*; and the atomic bomb ending the war. Concluding, he returned to today's situation: "Hopefully we'll get through *this global war* just as we got through WW II... it's time for us to come together and fight the pandemic."
