## LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Kimberly Pratt, of Alliance for Suicide Prevention, enlightened us about the facts of suicide and some tools to help people. Here are some





highlights: • In 2019 and 2020, the suicide rate (across the country) decreased for first time ever. • CO has long had 5th or 6th highest suicide rate (per capita). • Teenagers actually represent a small percentage of suicides. • In reality, white, working males, 35-65 yrs old

have highest suicide rate. • 80% of suicides in CO are done with a firearm. • Loneliness is a big factor. • "The key to suicide prevention is human connection."
