Don Rangel (*New Member Thumbnail*): One of our newest red badgers, Don, treated us to his 2-min story of his life. Some highlights:

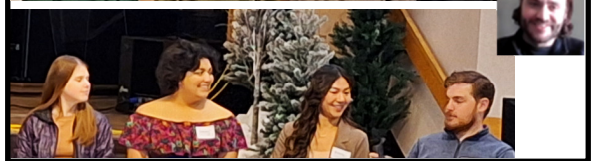


- He recently celebrated his 40th wedding anniversary with his wife Kristin.
