Proposed Bylaw change: The Board of Directors of Proposed bylaw change was the subject of a vote of the membership at our meeting. The change was overwhelmingly approved.

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Bill Emslie, our speaker last week, has a BS degree in electrical engineering from the United States Naval Academy and a MS degree in electrical engineering from Michigan State University. He also attended Colorado State University and the U.S. Navy Nuclear Power School. He is a retired captain in the United States Navy having served in the Navy Nuclear Submarine Force in both active duty and reserve assignments. Emslie spoke of the Natrium Nuclear reactor being built in Kemmerer, Wyoming as a replacement for a decommission (and polluting) coal plant. First Captain Emslie described the new technology for using nuclear energy, then he described the advantages (and potential disadvantages) of this new technology being introduced with the support of billionaire Bill Gates. He outlined how this new technology could support the future energy needs of the nation, including the increased need to support the requirements of AI, while providing safe and clean energy to the consuming public.
