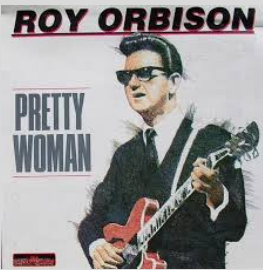

**Moofie Miller** introduced our speaker for the meeting, Sean Hawkins, Executive Director of the Loveland Downtown Development Corporation. He is a graduate of the Universities of Kentucky and Montana. Previously he worked on downtown, economic and tourism development in Missoula, MT, Corydon, IN and Yakima, WA. He loves spending time in the mountains with his son Jack and in taprooms in the front range.

### LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Sean Hawkins, Executive Director of the Loveland Downtown Development Corporation spoke on work by his group to reclaim the downtown Loveland commercial area. He discussed the corporation's Tax Increment Program that raises funds to improve the downtown area. He talked about the importance of their façade improvement programs that makes a more appealing environment for visitors to Loveland. He stressed the importance of the fire suppression program for our historic buildings and the Restaurant Conversion Pilot Program to assist investors bringing eateries back to the downtown and create modern and safe buildings. One of his major points of interest for club members was the activity around reviving the Pulliam Building. At the end of his presentation, he took questions from members of the club.
