LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Our own **David Snodgrass**, MD & Co-Pres **Bob Tello**, MD gave updates on the worldwide effort to eradicate polio and the current recommendations for the COVID virus, respectively. Highlights: • We've come a long way in eradicating polio since the scary 1950s scenes of medical wards full of patients on iron lungs. • In 2024, there are 54 cases of Wild Polio in 2 countries and 187 cases of variant polio in 17 countries. • Cases were lower during COVID, but rose once socializing resumed.
