#### **LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM**

Our own **John Turnage** told the surprising story of bringing water filters to needy people of Tehuacán (state of Puebla), Mexico. Some highlights: • Original goal was to place 1,000 filters in homes. • The intended Mexico Rotary club backed out of project, so they had to completely reorient the project! • The water filtration process was reengineered for very high sediment levels. • They procured 500 high-quality buckets (to avoid *a plastic taste*). • A contact at a hospital and a Rotary club president (once a Loveland exchange student) led the team to find remote villages where lots of people were excited to be trained to install, use, and maintain these amazing water filters.
