Bob Tello (Polio Plus): October is *World Polio Month*. Some of his remarks:

- In 1952, 57,000 polio cases resulted in 21,000 paralyzed victims (1 in 3).
- Polio history proves that if enough folks get vaccinated, the virus is ended.
- Rotary program (since 1985) aims to eradicate polio.
- Taliban (after fall of Afghan gov.) promises support.



PROGRAM

Guest speaker Elaine Kennelly (business woman & author) spoke about "Healing from a Suicide." Some highlights:

- The rate of suicide (2nd leading cause of death in 10-34 age group) has risen 33% in 20 yrs.
- After a suicide loss, it is common to slide into a pit of blame that is full of *self-pity, bitterness, and anger*.
- To heal, you can go from *unthinkable* to *unshakeable*.
- There are three components to healing: (1) change your *mindset*; (2) forgive others and experience a *release*; and (3) take the *baby steps* toward healing.
