PEACE FELLOW: Jim Epstein introduced the Rotary Peace Fellowship award winner, Jordan Mathews. Jordan is a graduate of Loveland High and received the scholarship for her master's program study in gender equality. She will study the techniques used in Sweden so she can apply them in other communities. Jordan served in the Peace Corps for two years (in the Dominican Republic) and her main focus was promoting gender equality by working with her neighbors and girls in the town.

PROGRAM: Phil Ashcraft introduced the Norther Colorado Banner Health COO, Wendy Sparks who talked to us about the Banner Health - MD Anderson partnership in Northern Colorado. MD Anderson is one of the world's most respected cancer centers and Banner Health is now a part of the MDA Cancer network as a satellite location. Since August of 2018, Banner has integrated the MDA program for managing and treating cancer. Wendy introduced Julianne Fritz who is a native of northern Colorado and serves as the Regional Director of Oncology for Banner Health. Iulianne told us about the collaboration with MD Anderson and how Banner can now take the existing cancer center to the next level with both treatment and research options.
