## A NOTE FROM OUR FOUNDATION

Thank you if you were able to attend our Rotary Thanksgiving meeting on Nov 14. We enjoyed showing you many of the ways our Loveland Rotary Foundation supports our community.

Due to a regrettable oversight, the Student and Teacher Recognition Program was omitted from the program. It is another important program that is funded through our Loveland Rotary Club Foundation. The program is coordinated by committee chair **Dick Bradsby**. Dick has led the program for many years.

The Student Achievement Award dates back to 1982. Over these forty years, students have been recognized for academic excellence, leadership and overcoming hardships. Each monthly recipient receives a certificate and a cash award. Students are nominated by school counselors.

Since 2005, Loveland Rotary Club has also recognized deserving teachers with a certificate and a cash award. In 2008-09, this teacher recognition became a monthly presentation. Nearly 150 teachers have been honored. Faculty members or staff submit nominations.

The teacher and student recognition programs have been financially supported through gifts from the Pulliam Foundation in honor and remembrance of David R. and Virginia D. Pulliam and through gifts from Rotarians and local businesses. \$10,000 per year is given to the teachers and students as honoraria.
