

Our own **Becky Huner** told us about "The House of Hope & Dignity." Some highlights included these:

- Becky's worked with Dignity: Liberia for many years; it is an organization devoted to women suffering from obstetric fistula injuries (a trauma resulting in incontinence), in this West African nation.
- This female, delivery-related condition can scar a woman emotionally, as well as physically, for many years, due to the stigma attached to it.
- Phase 1: Maternity Waiting Home - provide hospital care for women with delivery complications.
- Phase 2: Big Belly Clinic - among other services, will offer surgical repairs for a woman's existing fistula.
