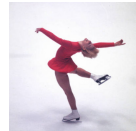
I was on a TV show called "Quiz Down" when I was in the 6th grade and answered correctly the question "What is a homonym?".

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Morgan Villnave, Community Engagement Manager at our local food bank, treated us to an eye-opening presentation on *Food Insecurity*. Some highlights:



- The *Three Pillars of Food Security* are: (1) *Availability*, (2) *Access*, and (3) *Education*.
- Larimer County doesn't have a problem with the first pillar, but we are challenged with the other two.
- The average monthly *food cost for a single person* in a 1-bdrm apartment in Colorado is \$533!
- Food Bank has 100 agency partners helping with the distribution of food.
- The majority of the constituents of the Food Bank are not the homeless, but rather single parents, the elderly, people facing huge medical bills, and so on.
