## LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Tyler Bandemer, Solid Waste Superintendent, for the City of Loveland presented information about the City's trash hauling and recycling programs.

The City of Loveland's solid waste program is recognized as one of the leading programs not only in the western United States but, also in the entire country.

The program is what is known as an enterprise fund, meaning that the program supports itself completely with revenue generated by the services it provides with no support from the general fund. The program is an \$11 to \$12 million service annually.

Tyler shared many of the unique characteristics and services that make the program stand out including - it is the only program in the state that puts snow plows on trash trucks to help with snow removal and they serve over 140,000 customers per year at the recycling center.
