

# Preventing, Responding to, and Reducing Risk





Dr. Jennifer Guthals (Director of Student Success for TSD) and Joe Vodjansky (Safety & Security Manager for TSD) thoroughly addressed "Risk Assessment In Our Public Schools." Highlights included the following:

- TSD uses a tiered system of support (leveraging both school building-based staff and specialized support professionals) to assess and manage risks of violent behavior and to help students find strategies to regulate their emotions and behaviors.
- Suicide prevention is also a major component of this support; more than 70% of people who commit acts of violence are known to have been suicidal.
- Joe Vodjansky and his risk/threat assessment team
  have a system for screening threats with 13 essential
  questions they ask about every reported threat.
