Dr. Tom Arnold, an award-winning optometrist, spoke on "Scleral Lenses & Other Optometric Issues." A summary:

• He is passionate about scleral contact lenses, which help patients with cornea-related vision problems. • For corneas that do not have a perfect dome shape, vision will be poor through both glasses and traditional contact lenses. • These lenses rest on the sclera which is the white part of the eye and work in conjunction with the fluid reservoir on the cornea.
