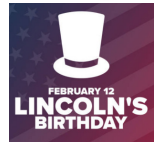

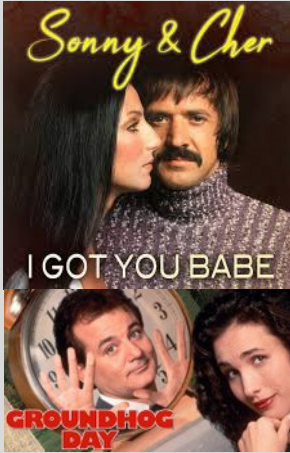

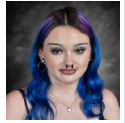

Logan Callaway, with *New York Life*, gave us a highly thought-provoking presentation about the reasons for Long Term Care (LTC) Insurance. Some highlights: • 70% of Americans age 65+ will need some type of LTC. • LTC costs (at home or elsewhere) are more than you'd think. • Medicare does NOT pay for LTC, although 57% of Americans think it does! • The older you get, the less likely you'll get approved for LTC. 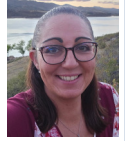
