LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Our own **Don Wells**, in delivering his talk, "A Perspective on Russia," conveyed many aspects of Russian history and culture, but also how the Russian people view their place



in the world. Some highlights: • It's the grammar, not the alphabet, of the Russian language that is so difficult. • Russia remains, even in the post-cold war era, the largest country on earth (geographically). • The concept of "the Soviet man" (egalitarian brotherhood) didn't pan out in actual practice because the system really fostered a class system (hierarchical tiers of ethnic, social groups). • Russians (particularly the older generation) exhibit a persecution complex (from the many invasions they've endured). • The Moscow subway system is perhaps the finest, best designed transit system in the entire world. • It's a fascinating country.

Russia=17,098,246 square kilometers (6,601,670 sq mi)

Many Russians, most notably, Vladimir Putin, still resent this loss and feel the world conspired against them to diminish their country and its influence. The Soviet Union Was comprised of: 8,650,000 square miles (22,400,000 square kilometers)

- So when the Soviet Union fell apart Russia lost 2,048,330 or 23.6 % of its territory. (Note that is just short of ¹/₄!)
- That would be like the U.S. losing 836, 360 square miles or more than the territory of Alaska and Texas combined.
