#### **PROGRAM**

The presentation on "Safe Water" by Roger Cabbage, Founder of Global Access 2030, included the following highlights:

 Globally, the lack of safe drinking water is a desperate situation: 1,000 children die every day fron

children die every day from contaminated water (WHO).



- Mission of GA2030: To ensure people worldwide have access to safe and affordable drinking water in support of UN sustainable development goal 6.1.
- GA2030 is a 501(c)3 founded in 2017 by Roger Cabbage; he never set out to develop a water filtration system, but that need soon became evident.
- The GA2030 filter is simple to explain, simple to assemble, and simple to maintain; this is why more than 700 people in Peru's Amazon region (who live on \$2 per week) have already benefitted: 100% of users report no more water-caused health issues!
- The GA2030 Team including Boulder Flatirons Rotary Club - is looking for partnering clubs, and is pursuing a global grant, in an effort to scale up the program for 9,000 more people in Amazon villages.
