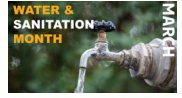

The new license plates approved by the Colorado legislature are ready and can be ordered now. If you want to order yours, see Jon for a special form you must fill out that verifies you as a Rotarian. Jon reports that he paid \$62.06 per vehicle (\$50 + \$12.06 fee) when he bought plates for two cars. There is no annual plate fee unless one has a personalized plate, in which case it is \$25 annually.

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Our own **Laura Armstrong** (Heart-J Center Executive Director) presented the history, affordable educational programs (only \$10 for



some classes), and future dreams for Heart-J Experiential Learning Center, at Sylvan Dale Guest Ranch, in the foothills west of Loveland. The Jessup family, which originally bought the land in 1946 and established the guest ranch, has begun the process of donating the property and its assets to the Heart-J Center. This donation valued at \$20 M is intended to protect Sylvan Dale - including the Cow Camp homestead (historic structures built in 1915) - for future generations.
