Ron Schlattman talked to the club about the grants committee's work in 2019. For the last year the committee has been working to use the money to represent service above self. The committee awarded \$34,677 in scholarship money for local and international projects. Grant funding for 2020 is similar.

## **PROGRAM**

**Dwight Brummet** introduced Dr. Branko Kosevic who is the director of weather systems and assement programs and the research applications laboratory of NCAR (National Center for Atomospheric Research) and works at the Foothills Lab with Dwight's son. NCAR is a federally funded research and development center who's purpose is to understand the behavior of the atmosphere and related systems.
