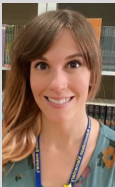

## LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Oscar Perez gave Loveland Rotarians an inside look at the world of modern railroading and how one "California kid" grew up to be a locomotive engineer and love it. Some highlights: • After being born and raised in East L.A., and serving in the U.S. Air Force for 10 yrs (incl. *Operation Desert Storm* and *Operation Desert Shield*), Oscar joined Union Pacific Railroad (where he's been for 29 yrs), rising through the ranks from brakeman to conductor to engineer. • It's important to realize that it can take a train more than a mile to come to a "sudden" stop. • The growing pressure in the industry to reduce crew size from 2 (conductor & engineer) down to 1 may put employees and the public at risk.



Let's not forget that railroads are essential to providing every necessity that keeps our nation running. 24/7, 365 days a year, we run and deliver coast to coast. So, while a trucker hauls one trailer, we haul hundreds at a time.
