LAST WEEK’S PROGRAM

Nancy Garnand introduced **Wayne Dehn** from the ACA Business Club of Fort Collins to present a program about **“Youth in Aviation”**.

Mr. Dehn presented information about the non-profit organization - Aero Cygnet - which uses aviation to help create a sense of purpose for young people. Youth can face barriers to becoming involved in aviation such as affordability, health restrictions and other qualifications. Through the work of Aero Cygnet, Wayne and the local chapter of the Business Club of Colorado work to remove these barriers. Aero Cygnet provides scholarships, the use of a flight simulator and other assistance to help more kids become involved in aviation.

Wayne’s club is also in the process of building a small plane, the Zenith 750 Cruiser, to allow youth to achieve a Sport Level of training. Even if kids do not become pilots, they are exposed to aviation and may seek out air traffic control or mechanics. More than 250 kids have been exposed to the program.
