- Who: The Roman Catholic Church
- Why: To unify the Church and centralize the power in Rome
- When: The Medieval Period (Middle Ages)
- Where: Western Europe

versally understood across the globe.

- Greek mathematician Pythagoras (470-525 BC) first discovered the concepts of *pitch* and the *octave*.
- A formal system for writing musical notes came about when Pope Gregory (by Constantine's order) developed a common liturgy (ritual of worship).
- The 5-line staff and clefs (treble, bass) came next.
- Musical notes known as *sharps* and *flats* were necessary to avoid the "devil of music" (dissonance from certain *natural* notes being played together).
- After that, ways to notate *rhythm* (beats), *harmony* (chords), *rests* (silence), and *nuance* (tempo) evolved!
