Our program featured personal reflections of both retired Loveland police chief Luke Hecker and our new police chief Tim Doran - remarks that were at times not only candid but highly illuminating about the lives and careers of police chiefs and the men and women they lead in service to the community. Testifying to how personally invested he's been in the Loveland PD and our community, Hecker said, "When I took off the uniform for the last time, it was like taking off my skin." He introduced our new police chief by explaining that Tim Doran had been very thoughtful and prayerful something Hecker calls a discernment process - before he decided to apply for and finally accept the job. For his part, Doran revealed he has viewed his new job as the "daunting task of leading a very proud police department that fell on some very challenging times."
