LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Our 2025 Governor's Art Show Kick-Off was very special this year. Several artists came in-person: **Diane Mason**, **Scott Ruthven**, **Elizabeth Rouland**, and **Jane DeDecker** - our keynote speaker, who's been in the art show for 25 years, has been sculpting the human form for more than 35 years, and has created more than 180 public sculptures in 38 states! But first, **Ashley Kasprzak** gave an overview of this annual cultural event (also a fundraiser for Loveland and Thompson Valley Rotary clubs), by explaining how "heart is at the center of our art show." As a result of this decades-long event (this year is the show's 34th year!), a total of more than \$4 million has been earned by Colorado artists, and proceeds have also gone to Thompson School District youth artists and literacy programs. This year's festivities start with a *Sponsor-Artist Appreciation Night* at Casa Sagrada, in Loveland, on Apr 18.
