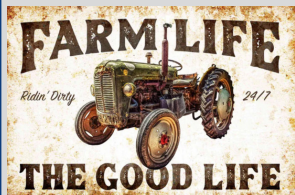

LAST WEEK’S PROGRAM

Diane Lapierre, along with Kathi Wright and Rodger Bailey (Thompson Valley Rotary), and Maureen Corey (Curator of Art, Loveland Museum) delivered the kick-off presentation for this year’s Governor’s Art Show & Sale. Over its 33-year history, this event has featured more than 500 Colorado artists and has raised more than \$4 M (after the 60% of sales to the artists) for both Rotary clubs and Thompson Education Foundation, to fund projects for at-risk youth, local nonprofits, and scholarships. The Opening Night Gala typically hosts over 500 sponsors and the art show welcomes more than 3,100 visitors from more than 17 states. Is this your year to become a sponsor?
