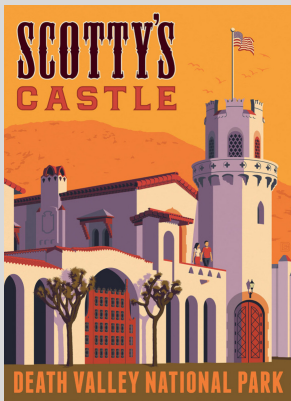

Behind the Scenes at Rotary

Or what it takes to keep our club growing, thriving, and afloat.
Brought to you by the Membership and Fellowship Committees

Diane Lapierre, on behalf of both the Membership and Fellowship committees, presented findings of the recent survey (75% of us participated!). There were three main consensus points achieved from the survey: (1) we all have different strengths and there are plenty of ways we can use our strengths to benefit our club; (2) everyone is in a different stage of life, and the type of engagement (in the club) of which we're capable shifts from stage to stage for each of us; (3) recognition is important, and more should be done to show appreciation to various members for all the different ways they contribute to the club's success.

Later, Diane kicked off table discussions with these two questions as the focus: *How have we been involved in the past? How would we like to be involved in the future?* Ideas that arose out of the discussions included these:

- Members would like to see the club come up with ways to re-engage with exchange students.
- Some of us have an interest in helping with discrete tasks rather than serving on a committee.
- More ways for members to make personal connections (something important for engagement) should be provided.
