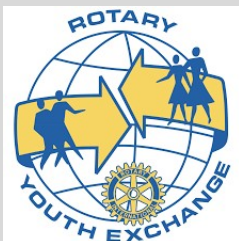

#### Personal Stories from Gaza

**John Turnage** introduced his brother **Mark Turnage** who shared information about Gaza from a Past, Present and Future perspective. Mark is the Chair of the Board of the American University of Cairo and visits the Middle East three to four times per year. Gaza is a territory of 2.3 million people who are 99% Muslim and 1% Christian. Gaza is 25 miles long and roughly 5 miles wide. Gaza has been ruled by Hamas since 2006. On Oct. 7, 2023, Hamas attacked Israel which set off months of war and destruction. Looking ahead it is not clear who could and would take charge in Gaza
