## Unlocking the Power of People Rotary Club Presentation April 9, 2024

Cheryl Smith, a retired teacher and now an activist on behalf of refugee communities in Colorado led a presentation about a most timely topic: *the issues involved in settling and supporting legal refugees to this country* - particularly those that through whatever means find themselves in Colorado. Since 1978, *Together Colorado* has organized people of various faith traditions to create a better world - one that values, uplifts and protects the humanity and human dignity of every person. *Together Colorado*, a network of congregations and faith leaders and a member of the national network *Faith in Action*, works at the policy level by educating and lobbying Colorado lawmakers regarding social justice for legal immigrants. A few highlights:

- A primary objective is "helping the un-homed" to find basic housing options.
- Their vision is "a sacred community where... everyone has the opportunity to thrive..."
- *Together Colorado* actively promotes relationship building through community resource clinics, youth centers (for language learning), as well as community clinics (for legal assistance).
