PROGRAM: **John Turnage** introduced Steve and Todd Olander who are 5th generation farmers in the area and currently own Root Shoot Malt and Olander Farms. The family's philosophy is to farm well and to take care of the land while providing customers with good products. The business has a malt crew and a farm crew and support education about ag/food growing practices. The farm hosts CO teachers for ag and Ag in the Classroom every year & this year they also had their first Field Days. Root Shoot Malt grows, steeps, germinates, and kilns the grain for brewers using a German malting method and equipment. This year they won best malt in the US with their Genie Pale Malt.
