- The organizers have been working for more than 2 years with the City of Loveland and its Parks and Recreation dept. to find the location and make plans.
- The *Wall of Remembrance* will allow folks to honor their own veteran with a named brick or plaque.
- A well-known local artist will create the *Entrance Sculpture* - that of an eagle.
- *The plaza's theme:* "Thank you for remembering."
