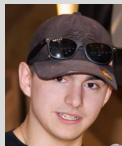

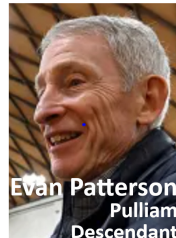
LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Our own **Evan Patterson** - whose great-great-grandparents (D.T. & Lillian Pulliam) gave the land and \$20,000 to build the original Loveland Community Building (now Pulliam Community Building) in 1936, and whose great-uncle and great-aunt (D.R. & Ginny Pulliam) owned ranchland that later became *Sylvan Dale Ranch* in Loveland and *Bobcat Ridge Natural Area* in Fort Collins - gave an illustrated talk on the locally famous Pulliam family. Family members still live in Loveland, Denver, Boulder, Colo. Springs and elsewhere, but with different last names (like Evan) because the four daughters (seen below) changed their names when married and D.R. Pulliam never had any children.
