Two grants were awarded: Ballet Renaissance and one to a school in Nepal for earthquake repair. A constitutional amendment passed to create a 2<sup>nd</sup> satellite club in Berthoud. **Rick Parker:** the Duck Race can use more help with sponsorships please let him know. **Jim Epstein** updated the club on polio eradication which is down from last year. However, due to misinformation about vaccines in Pakistan, operations have been shut down in that country for now. **Brian Nienhaus** announced that the Gov Art Show starts Friday, May 3rd and you can purchase tickets online at [governorsartshow.org](http://governorsartshow.org). KidsPak and **Tom Carrigan** were presented with a check from Subaru of Loveland. Tom thanked the Gebhardts for their support of the KidsPak program that they have supported for 6 years for a total of \$198,000 donated. This year they raised \$34,473 this year to donate to KidsPak along with supporting students going to the Disney on Ice show the last two years.
