

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Numerous Loveland Rotarians and their guests enjoyed the *Rotary Night at the Art Show* (an event held in lieu of our regular Tuesday meeting), last Wednesday, May 10. The 32nd annual Governor's Art Show & Sale - a month-long exhibit at the Loveland Museum with both in-person and online fine art sales - had just opened Saturday, May 6. This art event is recognized as one of the largest fine art shows to exclusively feature Colorado artists. This year's show introduces the public to 62 of Colorado's top fine artists. The net proceeds from the event will benefit Loveland and Thompson Valley Rotary-sponsored community projects and youth art scholarships. Several of those young scholarship winners were present and shared their art and their next career steps with those present.
