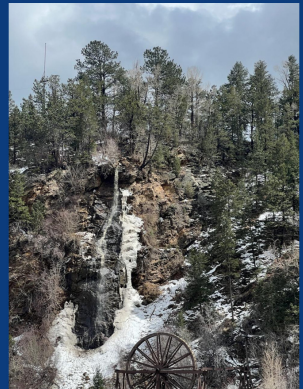
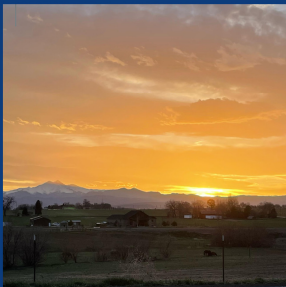
Lydia Wolfe (New Member Thumbnail):
