The Ins And Outs Of
Vaccines



Polio

- Pakistan and Afghanistan - two remaining nations with paralytic polio; vaccine-induced cases were rising, but thankfully, a new polio vaccine that will not induce paralysis has been developed.
- Rotary is still a primary contributor to eradicating it.

Influenza (the Flu)

- CDC estimates 22,000 flu-caused deaths, 2019-2020; there's a new high-dose vaccine for those 65+.

Coronavirus (COVID-19)

- Spikes on virus attach to ACE2 receptors on human cells, by which it enters cells and destroys them.
- Infected people spread virus for days before their symptoms; it can seriously damage multiple organs.
- Vaccine side effects = your body firing up to fight it.
